

Project Update

Stollery Children's Hospital: Pediatric Surgery



Overview

- This \$33.7 million project will expand the existing pediatric surgical suite at the Stollery Children's Hospital to accommodate current and future surgical needs.
- The project is required to meet increased surgical demands, including increasingly complex surgeries, that are carried out at the Stollery Children's Hospital.
- Total construction of the Stollery Children's Hospital Pediatric Surgery is expected to be completed in late 2016.
- The result of the project will be an increased capacity to complete up to 8,300 additional surgeries per year.
- This expansion required the relocation of existing spaces in the Walter Mackenzie Health Center to provide space for the project.
- Some areas were made available with the completion of the Kaye Edmonton Clinic and endoscopy suite relocation projects.

The units that required relocation include:

- Existing pediatric surgical suite
 - Outpatient surgery, day ward
 - Endoscopy
 - Neurophysiology
 - Family medicine clinic
 - Outpatient laboratory
- After the project is completed the following child and family friendly spaces will be created:
 - Five pre-operation holding beds
 - Four operating rooms
 - One specialty operating room
 - Twelve secondary recovery beds
 - Nine primary recovery beds
 - Two procedure rooms

Construction Update

- The main portion of the facility was turned over to Alberta Health Services on July 6, 2016.

- Minor finishing work will be undertaken.
